Our second graders will be exploring different ways people express feelings and ideas creatively **R.I.S.** Our Second-grade students will continue third semester with sixth unit of inquiry: An inquiry into the ways in which we discover and express ideas, feelings, nature, culture, and values; the ways in which we reflect on, extend and enjoy our creativity; our appreciation of the aesthetic.

Our students will demonstrate understanding of the central idea by creating a story or retell /act any story of their choice about feelings. Students will be able to create, retell or act a story creatively making sure they have a clear beginning, middle and end. This could include drawing, retelling or a performance of the story. Part of their performance will include why they have chosen this particular story and how it makes them feel.

This is a glimpse into what we will be doing for the next 4 weeks. The learning experiences are driven by the students. We are excited to guide our students through this process and we cannot wait to see what they will explore and create.

Central idea: people express ideas and feelings through writing. retelling or acting stories to communicate effectively.

Key concepts: Perspective, function, Connection.

Related concepts: communication.

Lines of inquiry:

Writing stories as a way to express ourselves. (Perspective).

How we use different stories to express different ideas and feelings. (Function).

Taking on different roles in different life stages. (Connection).

Approaches to learning (ATL's):Research skills / Social skills / Communication skills

Attributes / Learner Profile: Communicators / Risk - taker / Open minded.

Social Skills: Students will care for the needs of others. Students will listen carefully to others.

Research skills: Students will be aware of what they want/need to find out and they can ask questions to drive this inquiry.

Communication skills: Students will be able to speak clearly to express ideas so they make sense to others. <u>During math inquiry</u> students will continue unit11 "Data Analysis" In this unit they learn how to record data and analyze it describing the importance of labeling a set of data, they will also learn unit12 "Geometric shapes and equal shares" In this Chapter they will learn how to identify and describe Two- & three-Dimensional Shapes.

Learner Profiles / Attributes: Risk-taker

Students will learn to work independently and cooperatively to explore new ideas and create a story. Students are resourceful and resilient in the face of challenges and change.

Learner Profiles / Attributes: Communicators

Students will learn to express confidently and creatively in many ways drawing, retelling or a performance of the story. Students collaborate effectively, listening carefully to the perspectives of other individuals and groups.

Learner Profiles / Attributes: Open-minded

Students will learn how to be confident in their ability as learners, having the courage to take risks, apply what they have learned and making appropriate decisions and choices.
