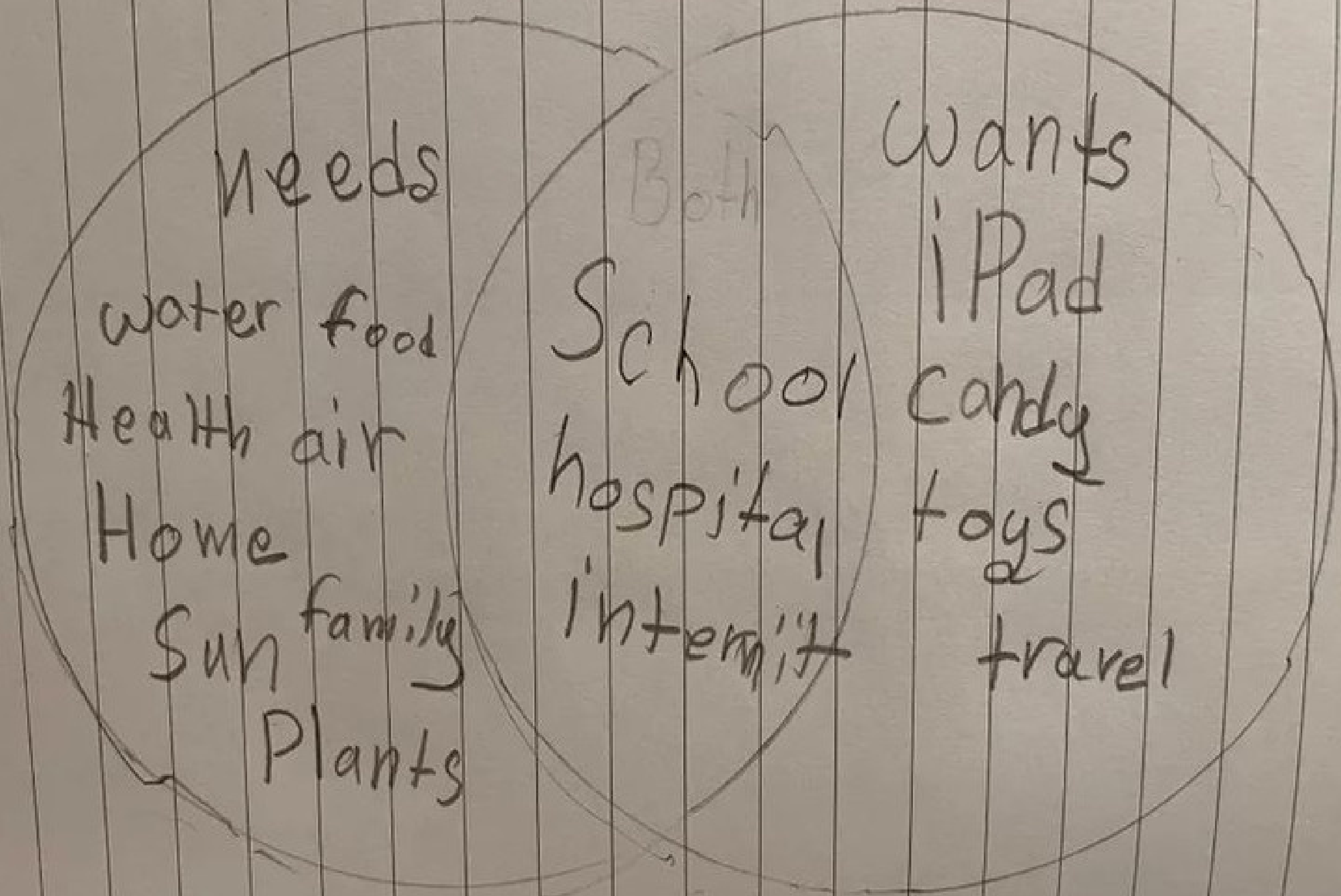


Venn Diagram

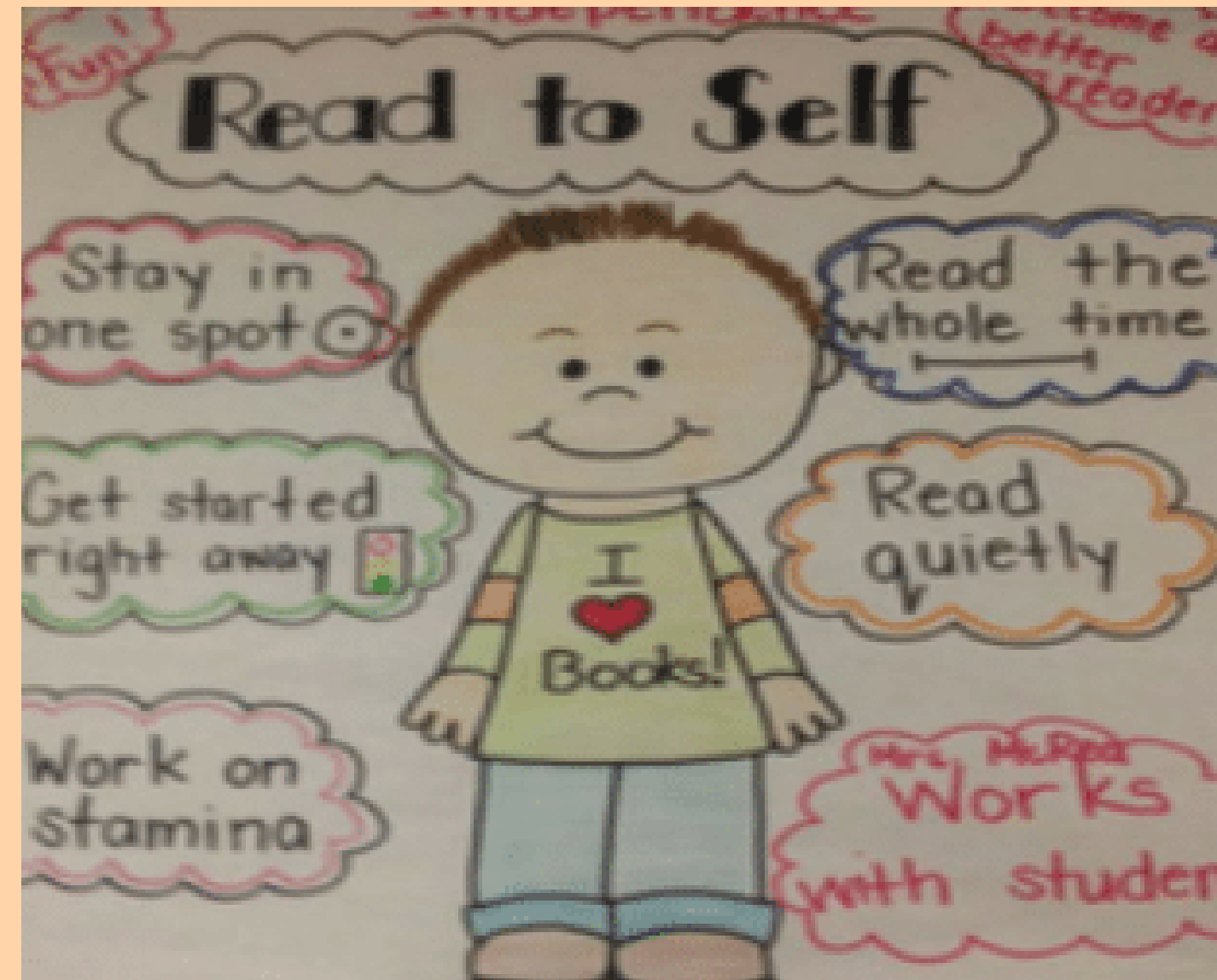

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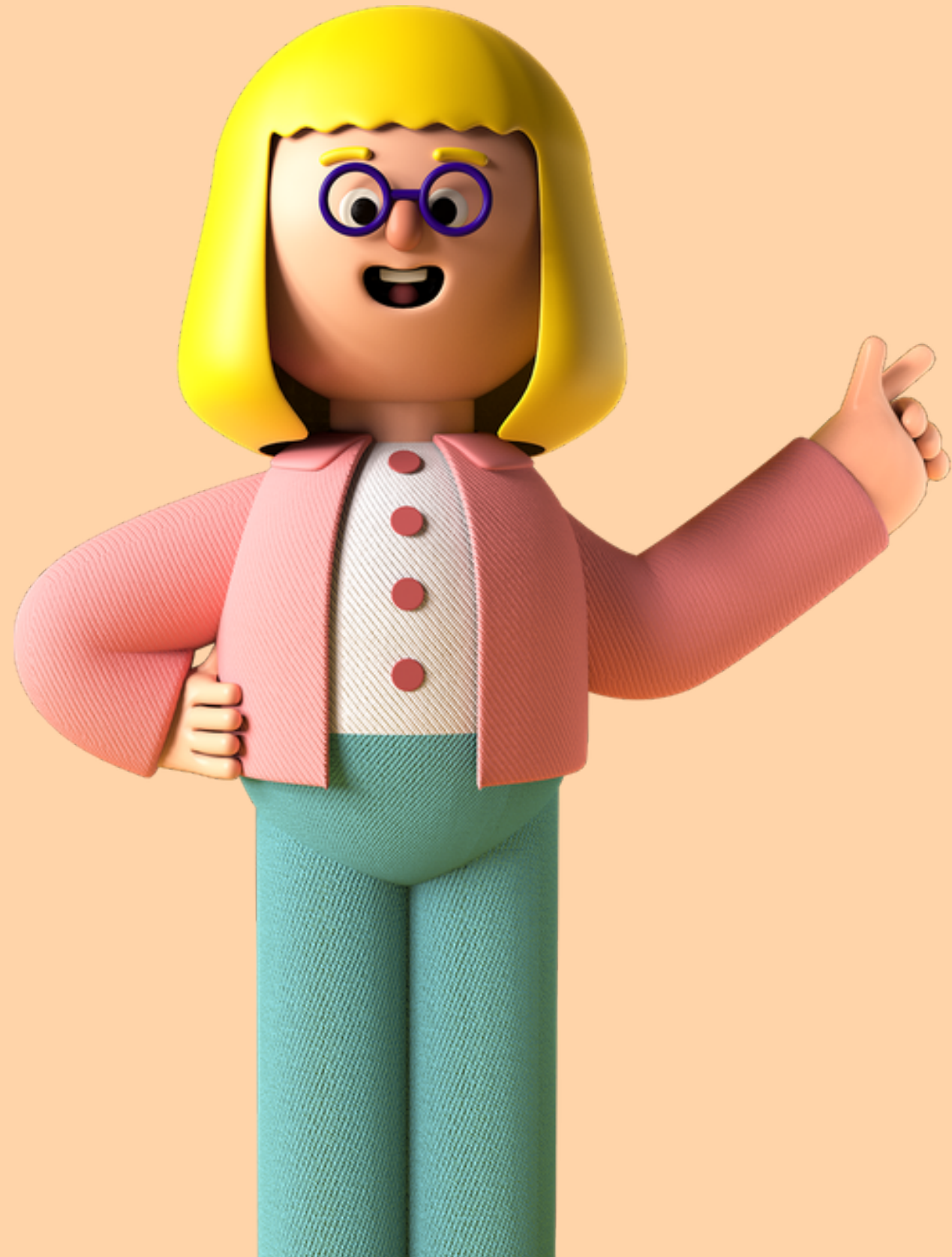

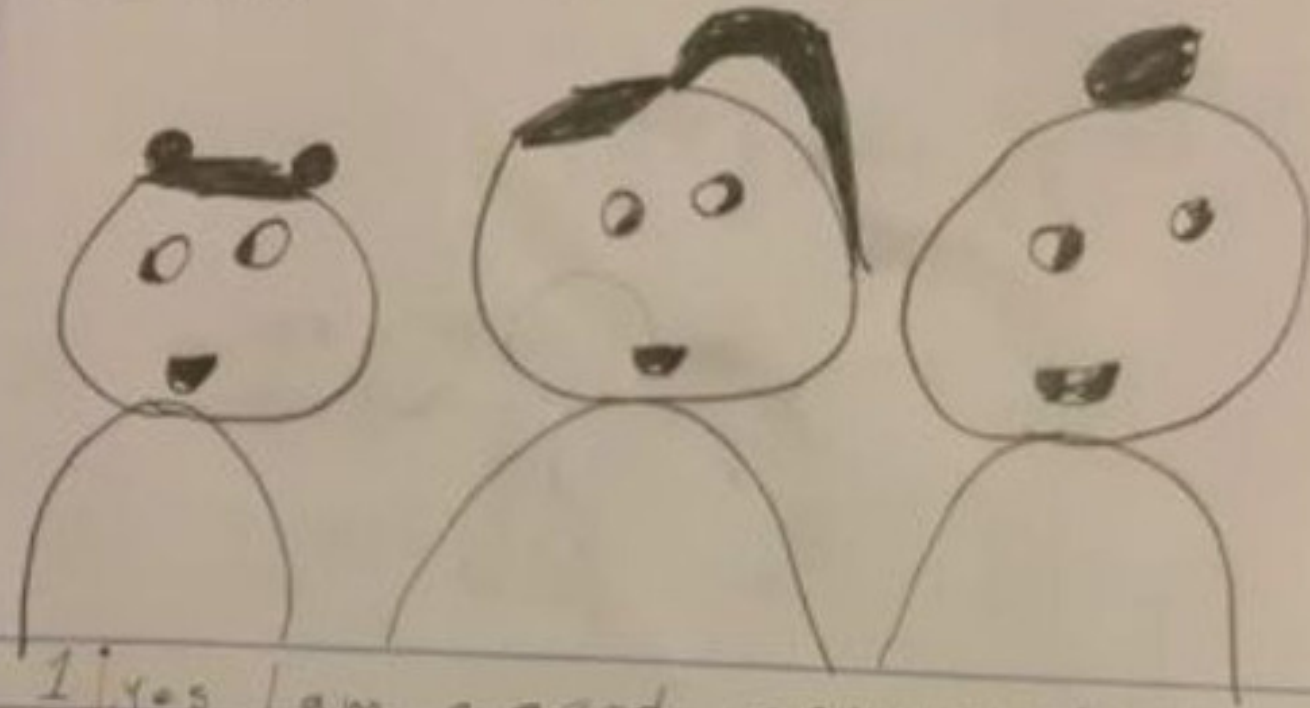

If will not sound good, because accidents will happen that make people sad and angry, and that community will be very noisy.




