How the world works
(Animals differ in their kinds and places where they live.)

Explanation:

By the end of the unit, the children will acquire the knowledge about animals, their needs, and their habitats. They will know about kinds of animals, what they need to grow and where they live. During the process of inquiry, they will be observed in getting mastery of certain skills of thinking, communication, search and social, besides developing the attitudes of knowledgeable and inquirer, and are ready to apply their learning in their lives connecting to broader ideas on how the animals' world works.
