

Making Good Readers

We will be sending sight words home every week. Begin having your child recognize the sound of each letter and try to form the word by blending the sounds. Then have your child practice reading the word as many times as she/he gets to read it by sight. Sight words are the words that are frequently in our reading and writing. When your child acquires a sight word that means he does not need to sound out each letter or phoneme in the word. When he/she sees the word and recognizes what it says and is able to read it automatically. As we grow into adulthood we acquire thousands of sight words. Unit of Inquiry

Inquiring Cycle:
Sharing the planet
(Animals and plants)
Central Idea: Living things
share the planet earth.

Explanation:

By the end of the unit, child will acquire the **knowledge** on how living things share the planet earth by **building the facts** with what living things are their needs and the responsibilities toward the planet. During the process of inquiry, child will be observed in getting mastery of certain **skills** of research and social skills, besides developing the **attitudes** - Tolerance and integrity in their personalities, and model the **attributes** of balanced and communicator, ready to **apply their learning in their lives** connecting to broader ideas how living things share natural resources under the **concepts** of responsibility, form and causation.




