Making Good Readers

We will be sending sight words home every week. Begin having your child recognize the sound of each letter and try to form the word by blending the sounds. Then have your child practice reading the word as many times as she/he gets to read it by sight. Sight words are the words that are frequently in our reading and writing. When your child acquires a sight word that means he does not need to sound out each letter or phoneme in the word. When he/she sees the word and recognizes what it says and is able to read it automatically. As we grow into adulthood we acquire thousands of sight words. Inquiring Cycle: How We Express Ourselves

(Explore Ideas Through Art)

Central Idea: We can express ourselves through arts. (Drawing, painting, craft)

Explanation:

By the end of the unit, child will acquire the **knowledge** on how kids can express their ideas through art **building the facts** with what are the types of art, their creativity encourage ideas and exploring ideas through art.
